

WIRED4MUSIC GENERATE

Guidelines and information on how to apply

The Wired4Music Generate Fund is an award of up to £500 for personal projects and up to £1,500 for community projects.

Personal projects are for individuals interested in enhancing and developing their own skills, knowledge and experience.

Community projects are for anyone interested in involving other 16-25s in their project, either as attendees or through paid opportunities, to enhance their skills, knowledge and experience.

Who can apply?

London-based musicians or creatives who are age 18-25 when applying and signed up as a Wired4Music member (sign up [here](#))

Your project should:

- Need Wired4Music's support in order to happen
- Be music-focused
- Be possible to start and finish within 6 months

What should my application include?

- You will need to show us in your application how you plan to spend the bursary and break down the costs into a basic budget
- You must be able to demonstrate how your project will benefit either your own development (personal) or the development of 16-25s involved (community)

What we don't fund:

- Projects taking place outside of the UK

- Projects happening as part of a course (i.e. college/uni)
- Equipment that has a value that is higher than 10% of your overall budget

I want to apply! What do I do next?

Book an idea planning session – chat through your idea and get some feedback. Sessions can take place in person or over the phone.

If your idea fits our guidelines, we will send you the information on how to apply in writing or by video.

Idea planning sessions are available on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays from Thursday 11 April – Tuesday 23 April.

The closing date for applications is Thursday 25 April 2019 at Midday.
